Try on a beautiful Korean traditional costume at Gyeongbok Palace! Enjoy free entry, take stunning photos, and feel like royalty as you explore.



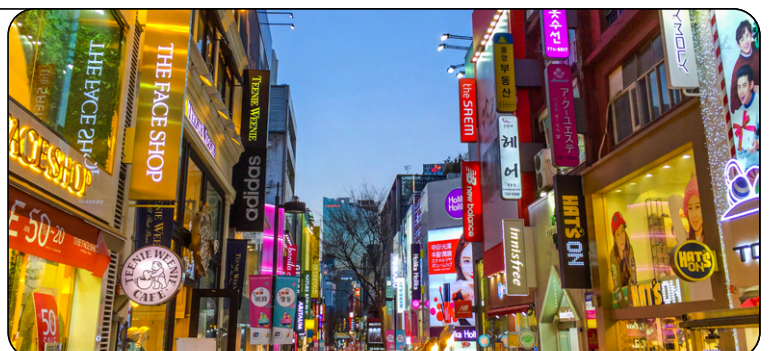
## Everland

## Seoul Night

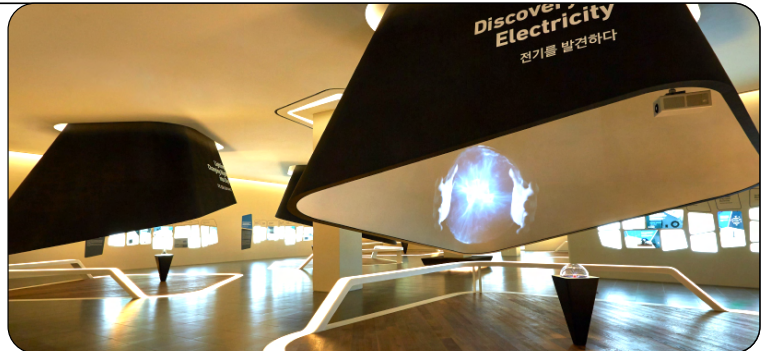
Immerse yourself in Seoul's local vibe by exploring places like Goto Mall and COEX Mall, all easily reachable by public transport.
