Ph.D program	- Applicants who have obtained (or are expected to obtain) a master's degree from a domestic or foreign university by February 28, 2026 - Applicants legally deemed to have the same degree as above
Undergraduate-Graduate Program (MA or MA-Ph.D Integrated Program)	- Applicants who are expected to obtain a bachelor's degree from Dankook University by February 28, 2026, and who are enrolled in the Dankook University Undergraduate-Graduate Program and have completed graduate-level courses. 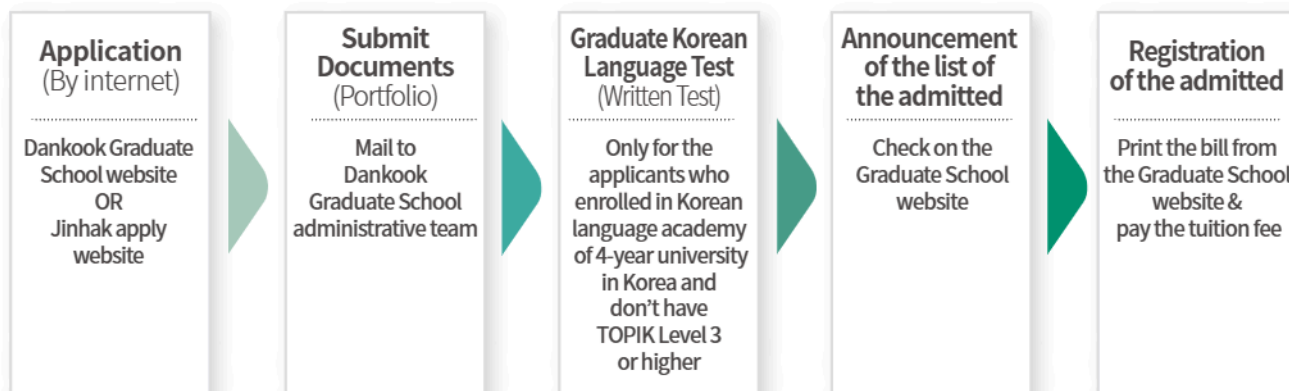

Basic Qualification	A person who is qualified to apply for a master's or Ph.D. program and meets one of the following eligibility criteria.
2nd Semester	Those who (will) have completed more than 1 semester and earned more than 6 major credits of MA or 9 major credits of Ph.D courses from domestic/overseas universities (including special graduate school) in same or similar majors
3rd Semester	Those who (will) have completed more than 2 semesters and earned more than 15 major credits of MA or 18 major credits of Ph.D courses from domestic/overseas universities (including special graduate school) in same or similar majors

\* Students of DKU Graduate School are NOT eligible for this category.

\* If the applicant for the second semester is a student in the first semester at the time of application, or if the applicant for the third semester is a student in the second semester at the time of application, an additional transcript stating the grades of the 2025-2 semester must be submitted by February 28, 2026.

\* The acquired credits are determined according to the transfer student's major and completed courses at the former university and if the acquired credits are less than required, the length of the program may be extended accordingly.

## 9. Compulsory Courses for the Students below TOPIK Level 4

<b>Complete 「Korean for graduate students」</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Register for “Korean for Graduate students” (3 credits, compulsory subject) in the first semester. In the first semester, international students can’t enroll for more than 6 credits (“Korean for Graduate students” 3 credits + Major 3 credits).</li> <li>- If the student fails to take the credit for “Korean for Graduate students” class, he/she should register for 9 credits (“Korean for Graduate students” 3 credits + Major 6 credits) in the second semester.</li> <li>- An additional 3 credits per semester can be earned for each semester “Korean for Graduate students” has been taken.</li> </ul>
<b>Complete 「Korean language course at Dankook University Global Education Center」</b>	Register for one regular course of Korean language course at Dankook University Global Education Center (Students must submit the transcript after the course.)

1. Admitted candidates who are expected to graduate must submit their graduation certificates and transcripts to the Graduate School Administrative Team (Graduate School building No. 317) before the opening day (Those who are to graduate from Dankook University don't need to submit the document.)
2. The transcript must contain a grade point average for both universities and graduate schools, and the graduation certificate must contain a degree registration number
3. If you transfer from a lower degree course, you must submit a copy of the certificate of enrollment (graduation, completion) and transcript of the university (graduate school) before transfer
4. All documents are valid within 180 days of issuance. An additional draft of resident registration must be submitted in the case of a person who has changed his/her name.
5. Applicants for the academic, research, and industrial cooperation courses must submit an additional letter of recommendation (using the institution's recommendation form) from the head of the institution that has signed an agreement with the graduate school of Dankook University
6. Professional soldiers who are serving for a long time must submit a school attendance approval letter from the Minister of National Defense (or the head of their unit). In case of dentistry, active military doctors must submit school approval from their head of military staff (or defense minister) and public health doctors, from the governor (or the mayor, health director, and head of the central deployment agency).

## A graduate from a foreign university

1. Applicants, from a foreign university have to submit the original graduation certificate and transcript in Korean (English documents can be replaced by Korean translations by themselves) and submit an academic background inquiry agreement (you can get it from the online application) must be submitted, and various certificates issued in other languages must be translated into English or Korean, and notarized.
2. A person who has obtained a degree from a foreign university must submit additional documents for proof of academic background (degree) (Refer to the document p.19 'Submission of Certificate of Academic background' – Apostille or notarization of the embassy)
3. The graduation certificate (education and degree certificate) of a person who has obtained a degree in China should submit the certificate issued by the Ministry of Education of China ([www.chsi.com.cn](http://www.chsi.com.cn))  
In case of a transcript of a person who has obtained a degree in China, it is recommended to submit a transcript certificate ([www.chsi.com.cn](http://www.chsi.com.cn)) issued by the Chinese Ministry of Education (if it is not possible to submit a transcript certificate, submit the transcript confirmed by consul or notarized)

## About the Evaluation Process

1. The admittees are selected according to the total scores, and the number of admittees may be limited in consideration for smooth operation of the graduate departments or majors.
2. During the screening period, all the notices are publicly posted on the graduate school website, not individually sent out
3. The interview will be conducted either offline or online, varying by department.
4. Applicants cannot apply two or more departments/majors simultaneously
5. Candidates once admitted cannot apply during additional application period. If so, applicants should give up their previous admission.



### Announcement of the admitted (including applicants on the waiting list)

1. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, the admission to DKU Graduate School will be canceled.
2. Entrance examination scores are not publicized.
3. Disagreement for the release of the academic records may lead to the cancellation of the admission.
4. Candidates may be placed on the waiting list in the order of scores, and if any of the first admitted have not registered, additional candidates may be selected in the order of their scores.
5. Announcement of the admitted applicants (including applicants on the waiting list)
6. Notification for the additionally admitted candidates on the waiting list will be through the phone with the applicants' contact information on the application form. If the phone is not answered, the next candidate will be an additional admittee, and our graduate school is not be responsible for this.

### Etc.

1. Terms of coursework and credits: Terms of study for MA and Ph.D courses are 2 years each or more, integrated course is more than 3 & a half years. **However, the duration of study for the Bachelor's-Master's Linked Program may be shortened according to separately determined regulations.**
2. Students are allowed to apply for the majors different from their undergraduate studies for MA & Ph.D.Degree.
3. Students whose majors are different from undergraduate or MA studies, or students graduated from special graduate school, are required to earn extra credits for the prerequisite undergraduate or graduate courses.
4. Some departments can substitute coursework or a research paper for the MA thesis. Please contact the department office for further information.
5. In accordance with the National Health Insurance Act and the Enforcement Rules of the same Act, foreign students are automatically subscribed to the National Health Insurance from March 2021

## 16. Information about Registration and Refund

- ① Be sure to complete the payment by the due date. If fail to pay, the acceptance will be canceled. (Please refer to Dankook Homepage to get the letter of acceptance and the instruction for Registration)
- ② A new or transferred student, if charged with a breach of admission policy as below will be sanctioned. Your admission will be cancelled even after the graduation. Submitted documents and tuition fees will not be returned. (You may be eligible for a refund when the tuition-paid semester are not end under the Article 6 of 「The Regulations on University Tuition Fee」.)
  1. If any required qualifications are not met, or if the principles prohibiting multiple applications and dual enrollment as stated in the admissions guideline are violated.
